Nagaland University, the 13th Central University was established based on an Act of Parliament of India and received the assent of the President of India on 20th November 1989.The University came into being on September 6, 1994 having jurisdiction over the entire state of Nagaland. At present the University has four campuses, viz. (i) Headquarters at Lumami (ii) Kohima (iii) Medziphema (iv) Dimapur.There are 37 departments offering undergraduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in different disciplines.
