Objective: The workshop aims at providing **Ph. D. Students in social sciences** (such as Psychology, Philosophy, Social Work, Sociology, Anthropology, Education, Teacher Education, Economics, Political Science, Population Studies, Management Studies etc.) a basic orientation in research methodology focusing on both quantitative and qualitative methods of research analysis.

Course Content: The content of the workshop includes What is Social Science Research?, Literature Review and Thesis Writing, Introduction to Research Methodology, Data Collection Tools, Research Design, Triangulation, Participatory Research Appraisal (PRA) Tools, Introduction to Qualitative Research, Ethnographic Studies, Formulation of Hypothesis, Types of Sampling Methods, Types of Social Science Research, Academic Writing, Computer Application in Social Science Research, Ethics of Research, Philosophical difference between the Natural and the Social Sciences, Scientific Writing for Journal Publication, Report Writing, Plagiarism in Research, Narrative Methods, Writing Research Proposal, Basic Statistics and Introduction to SPSS.

Eligibility Criteria: Young researchers who are pursuing their Ph.D. programme in universities or research institutions are eligible to apply.

How to Apply

- a. Candidates desiring to attend the Research Methodology Workshop have to fill the requisite **Application Form** attached below and submit to the Course Director through Email. A copy of **Recent Bio-Data** also has to be submitted along with the application form.
- b. The applications should be forwarded by the **Head/ Dean/ Research Supervisor** of the Institution/University of the concerned applicant.
- c. Applicants have to submit a note highlighting the present status of their research work duly recommended by the Supervisor, **a copy of the Registration certificate**, a synopsis/note on their research work along with their applications.
- d. It may be noted that as per ICSSR Guidelines, preference would be given to scholars from the neighbouring states of Nagaland.

Registration: The applicant has to register for the course after the confirmation of his/her selection for the course. The registration fee for the course is as detailed below:

- 1) Research scholars receiving fellowship Rs 500/-
- 2) Research scholars without fellowship Rs 200/-

Travel: Outstation participants are eligible for sleeper class train or actual bus fare subject to a maximum of Rs.1000/- per participant. Reimbursement shall be made only on submission of confirmed train tickets or original bus tickets. No local conveyance would be reimbursed.

Board and Lodging: Outstation participants would be provided modest facilities for stay and food on their request. Local participants would be provided only lunch and tea/snacks during the programme break.
