6. Recommendation of approval of re-constitution of board of School of Sciences.


7. Recommendation of Choice Based Credit System for the departments under the School of Sciences, viz., the Department of Anthropology, Botany, Geography, Mathematics, Physics and Zoology. Chemistry and Geology had already adopted CBCS system the last fiscal year, 2015
