Nagaland University, Kohima

Nagaland University is a centrally funded University established by an Act of parliament in 1989. It came into existence on 06th September 1994 with the former NEHU, Nagaland Campus, Kohima and SAS, Medziphema Campus. Now, University has three campuses with 45 departments located at Kohima, Medziphema and Lumami.

School of Agricultural Sciences (SAS), Medziphema Campus

SAS was established as College of Agriculture on 20th October 1978 by NEHU to cater the needs of development of manpower in the field of agriculture. The College was upgraded to School in 1985. It became part of Nagaland University since its inception in 1994. The School also became a part of National Agricultural Research System of ICAR in 2006. It is one of the premier institutes in the North Eastern Region in the field of Agriculture.

Department of Agricultural Economics

The Department of Agricultural Economics is a strong department of the University with nationally trained manpower. Apart from the regular courses in the under Graduate programme, the Department offers Post Graduate degrees in Agricultural Economics. The department has Ph. D. programme since 2005. Faculty has edited 18 numbers of books in the field of agriculture, marketing and allied sectors. Faculties were engaged in organizing national and regional level seminar on topics related to agriculture, marketing and allied topics. Department has conducted ICAR funded summer, winter and short course for faculty and advance training courses for non-teaching staff. Department has ICAR funded research project also.

Climate

The climate of Medziphema is pleasant round the year. The winter for about three months from November to February, though summer starts from April, weather is quite pleasant. Heavy rainfall occurs between June to August. During the month of September it will be pleasant and cool. A normal temperature ranges 12-26 ⁰C. It is advisable to carry light warm clothing.
