## Regulations for Introduction of PG Programme in Colleges Affiliated to Nagaland University, 2021

## Professional & Non-Professional.

- 1. Only colleges permanently affiliated to the University will be permitted to start PG Programme after assessing consistency of Good Academic Performance for 03(three) consecutive years after according Permanent Status.
- 2. NAAC Accreditation with at least "B" Grade shall be mandatory for colleges to apply for PG Programme.
- 3. The University will assess the availability of required infrastructure, at least 4 (four) qualified faculty with experience, adherence to UGC norms regarding the Pay Structure of Faculty, etc before granting Permission for PG Prgramme.
- 4. Initially only 2 (two) PG Programmes shall be permitted in a college. More PG Programmes may be allowed after assessing performance of the existing PG Programmes for 3 (three) consecutive years.
- 5. No additional Fee shall be payable by affiliated Colleges to the University for PG Programmes.
- 6. The College must have existing U.G. Teaching Programme (Honours) in the subject concerned for which University has granted Permanent Affiliation.
- 7. The College should have adequate Library infrastructure for PG Course.
- 8. Number of intake capacity/Seats shall be determined by the Inspection Team/Visiting Team and approved by the Academic Council, depending on infrastructural and academic resources.
- 9. The College may have their own admission Criteria which is to be approved by the University.
- 10. Syllabus provided by the University from time to time will be taught.
- 11. Nagaland University Ordinances and Regulations on Course Structure and Examinations, shall apply.
- 12. Principal and Faculty:
  - A. Qualification and Number of Faculty.
  - (i) The qualification for Principal and Teachers shall be as prescribed by the UGC/Regulatory Body of Govt. of India, from time to time.
  - (ii) At least 10 teachers (5 for UG and 5 for PG) in Science Stream.
  - (iii) Al least 8 teachers (4 for UG and 4 for PG) other than Science Stream.
  - B. UGC norms regarding Pay Structure of Principal and Faculty, etc, shall be adhered to. This should be assured prior to granting permission for PG programme to a College.
- 13. The Academic work load for every faculty member shall not be less than 40 hours per week for 30 working weeks in an Academic Calendar (15-18 weeks per semester) which shall include preparation, actual class room lecture, correction and examination work, seminars, admission and other professional works. The direct teaching hours per week shall not be less than 16 hours for every teacher. Minimum number of classes per week/per paper shall be same as that in the University PG Departments.
- 14. Inspection and Affiliation:
  - (i) Every College/Institution admitted to the privilege of the University shall be inspected as per the provision laid down in the Rules, Ordinances and Regulations of Nagaland University/UGC/ Regulatory Body.etc,

(ii) After approval of Academic Council, the affiliation for PG Programme shall be granted to a

College.

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
