Soybean farmer exposure tour to UAS, Dharwad, Karnataka

During the stay at UAS, Dharwad the farmers visited the off season soybean fields, Seed processing Plant, Institute of Organic farming, local nurseries and Front Line Demonstration fields of local farmers. Seeing the off season soybean field the farmers realized the importance and benefits of improved seed varieties, scientific cultivation practices and also the significance of seed processing in increasing yield. The resource person from Institute of Organic farming showed their museum and pointed out the various technologies available under Organic farming.
