



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
MINUTES OF THE 37th MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The 37th Meeting of the Academic Council was held on 12th Dec. 2023 starting from 3:00 pm in Blended Mode. At the outset, Prof. J.K Patnaik, Vice-Chancellor & Chairman welcomed all the members to the Meeting. He apprised the members on the progress of the ongoing activities of the University specially Recruitment of vacant faculty and Statutory positions through **Online Mode**- one of the first initiatives among the central Universities.

He informed the members that Biometric attendance system shall be introduced in all the departments by the next Academic session with autonomy to the departments to regulate. He informed that School of Engineering temporarily stationed at Dimapur shall be shifted to its designated Kohima Campus, Meriema by next Academic Session which shall be temporarily accommodated in the earmarked Linguistics department building till the completion of SET Building.
