

Meeting minutes of the 1st SWAYAM Advisory Committee held on 09.09.24

A meeting of the SWAYAM Advisory Committee was held in the office of the Vice Chancellor, Nagaland University on 09.09.24. The meeting was chaired by Prof. C. R. Deb in presence of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Nagaland University. The following members were present in the meeting:

At the outset, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed all the SWAYAM Advisory Committee Members and apprised about the 'Framework for University to Conduct Examinations for SWAYAM courses' as notified by the UGC vide letter D.O. F. No. 1-8/2017(SWAYAM) dated 27th August, 2024. After through deliberation, following resolutions were made:

1. The Deans of respective Schools will conduct meeting with the Heads of Departments of the concerned School and apprise about the courses offered and conduct of examinations in the respective Departments.
2. SWAYAM courses will now be mandatory for all UG/PG courses under the Nagaland University and minimum of one paper has to be taken by the student. If any student wishes to take more papers (interdisciplinary!) from the SWAYAM courses beyond the mandatory credits decided by the Department, students may be encouraged for that. However, these credits will not part of the core credits of the syllabus, but will be reflected in the transcript.
3. As per the UNC notification, now there will be two approaches for conducting the examinations.

A. The University can conduct the end term SWAYAM examinations along with the end semester examination in physical form. The designated Departmental SWAYAM Coordinator (DSC) will set the question paper; the student's Mentor from the Department may assist the DSC. In each semester, the student has to register and

select the course of choice. This will be provided by the DSC from the SWAYAM platform. Of the total marks/credits, 30% will be evaluated the Course provider through 'Assignments, group discussion etc. and remaining 70% will be evaluated through the 'End Semester' examination' and question paper setting and evaluation will be done the respective Department.

B. If any student wishes not to opt for end semester examination to be conducted by the Department, he/she may opt for writing examination conducted by the **National Coordinator/s** in online mode in the designated/approved centres.

4. The DSC in coordination with the Heads of the Department and SWAYAM Nodal Officer will select the courses (with credits) in advance from the SWAYAM Platform and notify to the students for selection of the course(s) and enrolment for the same. (this is to be done ahead of January and July when courses are usually advertised in the SWAYAM platform)
5. To pass in a SWAYAM Course, a minimum of 40% passing marks (i.e., **minimum 12/30 marks in Assessments/Quizzes and 28/70 marks** in the end term examination) is required. Further, the SWAYAM cell of the University will ensure that the student has submitted a minimum of 75% of the assignments and quizzes on SWSAYAM before allowing him/her to write end term examination. If any student fails clear the paper in the first attempt, he/she will be allowed to write the repeat examination in the subsequent two semesters.
6. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor advised the Nodal officer - SWAYAM to write to the NPTEL (National Coordinator) for the designated examination centres at Lumami and Kohima Campuses of Nagaland University.
7. Referring to point (4) - sub-category (1) the question paper should be set by a person who is well acquainted with the subject. If expertise is not available in the Department, students may be encouraged to take papers from allied/cognate/relevant disciplines. In both the above cases, the mode of examination will exclusively rely on the Course Provider/National coordinator [please refer to sub- point (2) under point (4)].
8. The SWAYAM cell is advised to prepare concrete guidelines on Credit Rationalization.
9. All necessary documents (University policy on SWAYAM) shall be made available in the University website.
10. If necessary, the Advisory Committee members may visit all the three campuses for workshops in physical mode.
11. Prof. C. R. Deb, Chairman - SWAYAM Advisory Committee has been advised by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor to convene a meeting of all the Heads of Depts. to discuss the modalities pertaining to setting of question papers.

The meeting ended with a note from the Chairman.
