## NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the 36<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting resolution NO.36:6:12, this is to notify the approval of Modification of MA/M.Ed (CBCS) syllabus on the following:

 (a) Linguistics: Minor Modification: Incorporation of Stylistics in Unit –V of Course XIII of Linguistics, Phonetics and Stylistics Paper and existing Unit-V to be merged in Unit-IV and in Course XV, Unit-III: Richard Joseph Frank land to be replaced by Jack Davi's *Play from Black Australia*.

(b) Change: *i*) In the Current MA Course, the dissertation is for 200 marks, spread out in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester. The department proposes to reduce it to paper of 100 marks in 4<sup>th</sup> semester. *ii*) The paper LING 402- Sociolinguistics and LING 404- Language teaching will be shifted to 3<sup>rd</sup>

*u)* The paper LING 402- Sociolinguistics and LING 404- Language teaching will be shifted to 3 Semester.

*iii)* LING -301 has four optional papers: One optional paper from 301- Language Planning which is an optional paper will be made a major paper in  $4^{th}$  semester. The other optional paper of LING 301 will be shifted to  $4^{th}$  semester.

- 2. English: TEN-203: English Poetry and TEN 403: Critical Approaches.
- 3. Hindi: Change in credits: reducing the unit in vocational education.
  - a) Change in Credits: The PG programme credits were reduced from 92 to 88 & reducing the Unit Vocational Paper i.e MAHIN 306: The units of Vocational Paper were reduced from 4 units to 2 as to justify the 2 credits allotted to the paper.
- 4. Tenyidie: Inclusion of 3 CBCS Papers in M.A Syllabus.

- b) Tenymia Culture and Folklore.
- c) Applied Linguistics.
- 5. Teacher Education: Minor modification in the M.Ed Syllabus M.Ed. CC104, 201, 304 & 403.
