About the University

Nagaland University, the 13th Central University and the only Central University in Nagaland was established by an Act of Parliament (No. 35 of 1989) and received the assent of the President of India on 20th October 1989 as THE NAGALAND UNIVERSITY ACT 1989. The University came into being on September 6, 1994 having jurisdiction over the entire state of Nagaland.

At present the University has four campuses, viz. (i) Headquarters at Lumami in Zunheboto district (ii) Kohima Campus at Meriema in Kohima district (iii) Medziphema Campus (School of Agricultural Sciences and Rural Development) at Medziphema in Dimapur district and (iv) a temporary campus at Dimapur (School of Engineering & Technology). There are 44 departments offering undergraduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in different disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Engineering & Technology and Management streams. There are 69 colleges from all over the state of Nagaland currently affiliated to Nagaland University.

About the Department

Department of Teacher Education of the Nagaland University is situated in Kohima Campus Meriema. The Department of Teacher education covers all emerging areas of education. The main aim of the Department of Teacher Education is to prepare teacher educators who perform optimally in the colleges of Teacher Education/Schools and other related research organizations. It offers M.Ed. and Ph.D. Programmes to empower individuals to be torch bearers of social change by transforming society with a coordination of material and moral framework of the groups to which individual belongs.

About the Programme

The capacity building programme (CBP) will aim to develop the capacities of the participants as the curriculum developer teams at the institutional levels. The programme will enhance the capabilities of teachers and teacher educators working in different colleges and universities across India to review and develop the curriculum as per the requirements and conditions of NEP-2020. The training methodology will include an interactive set of activities to enable the participants to use new processes and tools for curriculum development. The participants will be trained to identify and reflect on the current curricular needs of their particular programmes and to contribute for improving the same for creating skilful human resources, fit for better employment opportunities.

This programme on curriculum development will attempt to familiarise the higher education teachers with various concepts and theories of curriculum development. The planned schedule will include group work, interactive lectures, discussions, presentations, and excursion to offer theoretical as well as practical exposures. Resource persons from different disciplines will acquaint the participants to a broad range of domains of curriculum review and development.

Objectives

- 1. To review and analyse the existing practices used in the design, implementation and evaluation of curriculum
- 2. To provide training for competency-based curriculum development
- 3. To facilitate the exchange of experiences among participants
- 4. To provide hands-on training for using ICT tools helpful in the curriculum development and transaction processes
- 5. To identify some common trends and successful practices based on the experiences revealed in the participants' discussions and deliberations, and to publish the same for the benefit of other teachers, teacher educators, curriculum designers, researchers and other stakeholders of the education system in India

Target Participants/Eligibility

Teachers and teacher educators of all disciplines from Social Sciences and Humanities, working in various colleges and universities from across India are eligible to take part in this capacity-building programme for curriculum development.

Duration and Venue

This is a two weeks (12 days) programme going to be conducted w.e.f. 26th October to 06th November 2023. The CBP will be organized at the Kohima Campus of Nagaland University.

How to Apply

- a. Higher education teachers desiring to attend the Capacity Building Programme on Curriculum Development have to fill requisite **Application Form** attached below and submit to the Programme Director through Email (Soft Copy). A copy of **Recent Bio-Data** also has to be submitted along with the application form.
- b. Applications along with relieving (for the complete programme duration) duly approved/signed (with seal) by the Principal/Head/Registrar of the Institution/University will be considered for entry into the programme.
- C. It may be noted that as per ICSSR Guidelines, out of total 20 seats 10 will be allotted to out-of-state participants and 10 will be allotted to the within-state (Nagaland) participants. Preference would be given to the eligible candidates on a first come first basis.
- d. It is requested to all participants that after confirmation of participation through email, you've to be ready with a personal laptop/computer with SPSS and MS Excel softwares installed along with a high-speed internet connection for deriving maximum benefits from the Capacity Building Programme.

Registration: No registration fee

Travel: Outstation participants are eligible for 3rd AC train or actual bus fare subject to a maximum of Rs.3000/- per participant. Reimbursement shallbe made only on submission of confirmed train tickets or original bus tickets. No local conveyance would be reimbursed.

Board and Lodging: Outstation participants would be provided modest facilities for stay and food on their request. Local participants would be provided only lunch and tea/snacks during the programme break.

The number of seats is limited to 20 (10 out of the State and 10 within the State) only.

Last Date of Application: The last date for submission of the application is September 20, 2023 (Wednesday). The selected applicants shall be intimated through E-Mail and also the list will be displayed on the university website on September 25, 2023 (Monday). 
