About the Institution

SRM Institute of Science and Technology (formerly known as SRM University) is one of the top-ranked universities in India, with over 52,000 students and 3,200 faculty members, offering a wide range of undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programmes in engineering, medicine and health sciences, management, science and humanities, law, and agricultural sciences.
