About the University:

Nagaland University, the 13th Central University and the only Central University in Nagaland was established by an Act of Parliament (No. 35 of 1989) and received the assent of the President of India on 20th October 1989 as THE NAGALAND UNIVERSITY ACT 1989. The University came into being on 6th September, 1994 having jurisdiction over the entire state of Nagaland. At present the University has three campuses, viz. (i) Headquarters at Lumami in Zunheboto district (ii) Kohima Campus at Meriema in Kohima district (iii) and Medziphema Campus (School of Agricultural Sciences) at Medziphema in Chümoukedima district. There are 44 departments offering undergraduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in different disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Social Sciences, Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Engineering & Technology and Management streams. At present there are 77 colleges in Nagaland affiliated to Nagaland University.

About the Department of Management:

The Department of Management under the School of Management Studies (SMS) was inaugurated on the 29th of October, 2007. The first batch of MBA consisting of 30 students was admitted in July, 2008. Admission for MBA Programme is done on the basis of MAT conducted by AIMA, CMAT (AICTE), XAT, CAT, ATMA and CUET (P.G.). This is done in order to maintain its standard by selecting the right kind of students. In addition to that, the department also conducts NU-MAT which is of equivalent standard of National level tests for admission to the MBA Programme. The department believe in the Holistic Development and Growth of the Students in terms of their academic, personality, entrepreneurial ability and employability. The Department have a computer lab and the classrooms are provided with all required teaching aids. The Department offers three programmes i.e. MBA, Executive MBA (EMBA) & Ph.D. in Management and presently there are 15 Research Scholars pursuing their Ph.D. in Management. The Department also proposed to start Post Graduate Diploma in Tourism and Travel Management (PGDTTM) & Post Graduate Diploma in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management (PGDESBM) in the next academic year 2025.

About the Department of Education:

The Department of Education was established on 7th September, 1978 as Department of Educational Research, under NEHU, Nagaland Campus. Later it was re-named as Department of Education which came under Nagaland University on 6th September, 1994. The Department is under the School of Humanities and Education. The Department offers two programmes i.e. P.G in Education & Ph.D. in Education and presently there are 48 Research Scholars pursuing their Ph.D. in Education.

Objective of the Workshop:

The main objective behind this Workshop is to give exposure on research methodology and data analysis to M.Phil./Ph.D./PDF Research Scholars. The programme will focus on foundations of quantitative, qualitative and mixed-methods of research. In addition to dealing with philosophical and theoretical aspects of social science research, the workshop proposes to deliberate with the participants on aspects of defining research problems, framing research questions, formulation of hypothesis, exploring data sources, review of literature, data collection methods and tools, data analysis techniques, various aspects related with report writing and article publication tips in social sciences. It is also envisaged to provide an orientation with relation to use of important statistical methods in analyzing both qualitative and quantitative data

Pedagogy:

Different topics of research methodology shall be taught through different pedagogical tools like lectures, hands-on training on computer software, assignments to write research proposal, designing instrument for data collection, Article Preparation, Publications and field work for data collection. The participants will be required to make presentations and submit a report at the end of the workshop.

Course Content:

The content of the workshop includes Nature, Importance and Scope of Educational Research & Nature of Scientific Methods and its Application to Education, Review of Related Literature, Types of Research, Steps in the Process of Research & Research Proposal, Experimental Designs, Hypotheses: Concept & Types of Hypotheses, Formulation of Hypothesis, Testing of Hypothesis, Types of Sampling: Probability Sampling & Non-Probability Sampling, Data Collection Tools, Web Tools in Research, Grounded Theory & Case Studies, Report Writing/Thesis Writing, Tool Standardization, Ethnographic Research, Variables and Types of Variables, Research Paper Writing, Plagiarism in Research, Issues in Research Field work, References and Citations, Book Publication & Journal Publication, Ethics in Research, Plagiarism in research, Computer Applications in Social Science Research, Basic Statistics and MS-Excel and SPSS, Library & e-library training, Use of Data in Social Science Research.

Eligibility Criteria:

Young researchers who are pursuing their M.Phil. /Ph.D. / PDF. Programme in Social Sciences in universities or research institutions are eligible to apply.
