Nagaland University is a centrally funded University established by an Act of parliament in 1989, hqr at Lumami, it came into existence on 06th September 1994 with the former NEHU.

Eligibility

Applicant preferably may be PG in Social Science discipline viz; Economics / Agricultural Economics / ABM / Rural Development either doing M. Phil or Ph. D. from UGC's affiliated college / CU / SAU / ICAR etc; A maximum of 30 participants will be selected based on their qualification and area of research work. The decision of the selection committee will be final and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained for non-selected candidates.

Travel, Lodging and Board

All the selected participants will be paid travel fare for to and fro journey by the rail / bus shortest route, restricted to the Sleeper class and TA will be paid on the production of original tickets only. Free boarding and lodging (shared basis) will be provided to the participants during the training period. The participants should abide by the rules and regulations of the university. The local candidates are not eligible for boarding and lodging, however, the local hospitality (lunch, tea, snacks etc;) will be provided to them.
