# PROMOTION OF WOMEN ENTREPRENEURSHIP THROUGH INTEGRATED SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME.

The Women's Studies Center, Nagaland University in collaboration with Entrepreneur Development & Integrated Training Institute (EDITI) Kohima successfully conducted the proposed integrated skill building programme, "**Promotion of Women Entrepreneurship through Integrated Skill Development Programme**" from 14<sup>th</sup> -20<sup>th</sup> September 2019 sponsored by Nagaland Sate Social Welfare Board (NSSWB).

The training was conducted on experiential basis to be up-scaled in future incorporating other feasible vocations basing on the outcome of the program. The primary goal of the program was to provide training on potential skills which can be taken up as meaningful trades and jobs. Therefore, such skills/trades and industries like beading, artificial flower, miniature dolls, pottery etc. which have market viability and can be taken up by women even from her home in a sustained manner were selected to be imparted.

The training was availed by 25 girls in each trade totaling to 100 beneficiaries. The training commenced with a formal program where the Director of Women's Studies Centre – Prof. Buno Zetsuvi gave a motivational talk on the importance of women entrepreneurship and the Managing Director of Entrepreneur Development and Integrated Training Institute (EDITI)-Mezi Angami talked on the nuances of entrepreneurial approach and scope.

The program saw a very enthusiastic respond from the institution and the target group. Brief detail of the programme is highlighted below.




