Guidelines for MBA Admissions 2020

1. The Online Nagaland University Management Aptitude Test (NU-MAT) 2020 (online written test) will be held at 10 am on November 07, 2020. The format of the test is: 100 multiple choice questions on English language (15 questions), General Knowledge (15 questions), Quantitative Aptitude (35 questions) and Reasoning (35 questions).
2. The students can write the online NU-MAT 2020 as well as appear the Personal Interview from the comfort of their home. In case of students residing in far flung areas where internet service is not available, they may approach their respective district administration office where NIC is located. The University is in no way responsible for any internet issue at the time of online written test or Personal Interview.
3. The Examination Coordinator will circulate a google form link in whatsapp at 10 am on the Examination day (November 07 and 09, 2020) which has to be mandatorily filled up by all the candidates by 10.20 am. This google form is for taking attendance during the Examination. Please note that, non-filling the attendance sheet may lead to disqualification from the entire admission process.
4. **The online written test will be conducted via <https://quizizz.com> . All the candidates need to log in to the website in order to take the test. The log in can be done using the respective Gmail account of the students. Please note that, the registered name in <https://quizizz.com> should match the registered official name of the candidate (Pet name, nick name not allowed). Any mismatch may lead to disqualification from the entire admission process. The online written test will be started exactly at 10.30 am and finish by 12.30 pm. The link for the test also will be shared via Whatsapp group before start of the examination.**
5. **Each multiple choice question will carry 2 marks. There will be negative marking (25% marks = 0.5 marks) for each wrong answer. Therefore, proper care needs to be taken while marking answers. If someone does not know any answer then he/she can bypass that question.**
6. After the scheduled closing time (12 noon), the University will evaluate the answer sheets. The marking will be done based upon the number of correct answer given minus the negative marks. Ignore any other score displayed by the website such as points etc.
7. The Personal Interview will be conducted via Google meet on the November 09, 2020 from 10.30 am onwards serially application number wise. The google meet link will be shared in whatsapp group.
8. **The students are instructed to clear their doubts (if any) regarding online written test and Personal Interview by posting queries in the whatsapp group or email on 5th and 6th of November 2020. The whatsapp group will be open for posting messages by the students at 6 pm on 5th November and 1 pm on 6th November for one hour only on both days.**
9. An online mock test which is mandatory for the students will be conducted by the Department on 06/11/2020 at 11.30 am.
