Guidelines to candidates applying for admission to M.A. Programme in the Department of Political Science for academic sessions (2022-23).

- 1. Selection will be done purely on merit, based on the marks /percentage scored in undergraduate programme.
- 2. Students are requested to calculate only the marks scored in all political science papers both major and general and then divide the total marks with total number of papers to calculate their percentage. (eg. Percentage= total marks scored in all political science papers divided by 14).
- 3. Submission of online forms: 1st -21st July 2022.
- 4. Screening of applicants 25th -27th July 2022
- 5. First list of provisionally selected candidates, 28th July 2022.
- 6. Admission for the selected candidates, 29th 31st July 2022.
- 7. Second list of provisionally selected candidates, 1st August 2022(subject to availability of vacancy)
- 8. Admission for the selected candidates, 2nd 3rd August 2022.
- 9. Applicants are advised to refer to the prospectus (2022) on the university website (www.nagalanduniversity.ac.in and apply accordingly.
- 10. Incomplete forms without supporting documents will be rejected.
