- 1. List of shortlisted candidates for 'Entrance Test' will be available in the Nagaland University website on December 04, 2023.
- 2. All information will be published only in the Nagaland University website. No separate call letter/intimation will be issued in connection with the admission process. Candidates are advised to keep track of updates in the NU website.
- 3. The syllabus of 'Entrance Test' will be the PG (Botany) syllabus and question pattern will be 'Multiple Choice Question' (MCQ) and short descriptive (Research Aptitude) types. There will be 70 MCQ and each question will carry 1 mark (total 70 marks), 6 short questions (5 marks each, 30 marks).
- 4. Selection will be made based on the 70% entrance test result, 30% equivalent of Vivavoce. A candidate must score at least 50% in aggregate in Entrance Test Result (combining all three categories) to qualify in the Entrance Test. Merit list will be prepared only from the qualified candidates.
- 5. Date of *Entrance Test' (offline) is December 08, 2023 at 11.00 AM in the Department of Botany, Nagaland University, Lumami followed by ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS verification and Viva-voce. Any candidates fails to produce original documents, their candidature will be disqualified.
- 6. Preference will be given to NET-JRF qualified candidates and <u>candidate having PG degree</u> in <u>Botany/Plant Science</u>.
