Guidelines for candidates applying for admission to M.A. Programme in the Department of Political Science for the academic session 2023-24.

- 1. Selection will be done purely on merit basis based on the marks /percentage scored in undergraduate programme.
- 2. Students are requested to calculate only the marks scored in all political science papers both major and general and then divide the total marks with total number of papers to calculate their percentage.
- 3. Submission of online form: 1st -20th July 2023
- 4. Screening of application and admission: 21st July 3rd Aug 2023
- 5. First list of provisionally selected candidates: 24th July 2023
- 6. Admission for the selected candidates: 25th -26th July' 2023
- 7. Second list of provisionally selected candidates: 27th July 2023 (subject to availability of vacant seat/s)
- 8. Admission for the selected candidates: 28th -30th July 2023
- 9. 3rd list of provisionally selected candidates: 31st July 2023 (subject to availability of vacant seat/s)
- 10. Admission for the selected candidates: 1st 2nd Aug 2023
- 11. Applicants are advised to refer to NU Prospectus 2023-2024 on the university website www.nagalanduniversity.ac.in and apply accordingly.
- 12. Incomplete forms without supporting certificates/documents will be rejected.
- 13. Uploaded documents should be clear and visible otherwise it will stand rejected.
