INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES OF NS Ed CET -2020

A Common Entrance Test, designated as Nagaland State Education Common Entrance Test-2020 (NS EdCET -2020) will be conducted by the CONVENER, NS EdCET - 2020, Nagaland University, Kohima Campus, Meriema, Nagaland-797 004 for admission into B.Ed. Regular Course(2 Years) in the Colleges of Teacher Education in Nagaland State for the academic year 2020-2021.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR FOR NSEdCET -2020

(i) Candidates satisfying the following requirements shall be eligible to appear for NS Ed CET -2020.

- (i) The Candidates should be Indian Nationals.
- (ii) The Candidates should satisfy Local/Non-Local status requirements as laid down in the Nagaland State.

(iii) The number of seats available for admission to each College will depend upon seats authorized by the University as per NCTE norms.

(iv) Educational Qualifications:

(a) Candidates should have passed/appearing for final year examinations of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./ B.C.A./B.B.M. at the time of submitting the Application for **NS EdCET -2020**. Candidates should be required to produce marks memo and pass certificate at the time of admission.

(b) Candidates should have secured a minimum of **55% marks** either in the Bachelors Degree i.e.B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A./B.B.M and or in the Postgraduate Degree in relevant subject or 5 years integrated course in the relevant subject of methodology or any other qualification equivalent there to. The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per Central Government/ Stat Government/Nagaland University/NCTE norms, whichever is applicable.

Note: The candidates who passed B.E / B.Tech with a minimum of 55% marks, with Mathematics, Physics are eligible for admission into the Course.

(v) **Age Limit:** The candidates should have completed the age of 19 years on the date of notification is issued. There shall be no maximum age limit.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE CHOICE OF SUBJECT SECTION -C

METHODOLOGY ELIGIBILITY

1. Mathematics: Candidates with B.A. /B.Sc. with Mathematics as one of the group Subjects or B.C.A. candidates with Mathematics at intermediate level as a group subject.

B.Tech with Mathematics & Physics

2. Sciences: Candidates with B.Sc. /B.Sc.(Home Science) who have studied Botany and Zoology or Allied Life Sciences group subjects or B.C.A.Candidates with Biological Sciences at intermediate level as group subjects. Candidates with B.Sc. who have studied Physics and Chemistry or Allied Material Sciences group subjects or B.C.A. candidates with Physical Sciences (Physics and Chemistry) at intermediate level as group subject.

3. Social Studies: All candidates with B.A. /B.Com. /B.B.M. or B.C.A. candidates with Social Sciences at intermediate level as group subject.

4. English

Candidates with B.A English / Special English / Alternative English or M.A. English

5. Tenyidie

Candidates with B.A Tenyidie or M.A. Tenyidie

MEDIUM OF ENTRANCE TEST

The question paper will be in English.

CENTRES OF ENTRANCE TEST

The Common Entrance Test will be held at the following Centres.

1) Kohima

2) Dimapur

3) Mokokchung

However, Convener reserves the right to allot candidates to any other center(s) in unavoidable circumstances.

QUALIFYING MARKS

The qualifying marks in the Entrance Test for all candidates (except SC/ST) are 37 out of total marks (i.e. 25%). For the candidates belonging to SC/ST communities, there will be no qualifying marks for ranking. There will be no minimum qualifying marks for women in Sciences / Mathematics methodologies.

RESULTS

RANKING: Candidates will be ranked in each methodology in the order of merit on the basis of marks obtained in **NS EdCET - 2020** examination. Where there is a tie in total

marks, Section-C marks will be taken into account to decide relative ranking. In case of further tie, the marks obtained in Section-A will be taken into account to decide relative ranking.

In case of candidates getting equal marks in each of the parts of the test paper, they shall be bracketed for the purpose of award of rank. At the time of admission into the course, age shall be taken into consideration for relative ranking among the bracketed candidates and the older candidates shall be given priority.

The rank obtained in **NS Ed CET - 2020** is valid for entry into B.Ed. course for the academic year 2020-2021 only.
