About the Programme:

Department of Education, Nagaland University, Kohima Campus, Meriema is organizing an ICSSR sponsored Two Weeks (14 days) course on ‘**Capacity Building Programme for Social Science Faculty Members**’ including Education, Teacher Education, Psychology, Commerce, Management, Economics, Sociology and Social Work, Anthropology, Political Science, Public Administration, Economics, History, Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology, Geography, Population Studies, Women Studies, Law & International Law and allied disciplines for the benefit of University as well as College teachers during **8th May to 21st May 2018** in collaboration with the Department of Teacher Education, Nagaland University, Kohima Campus. The purpose behind the programme is to enhance the capability of conducting quality research among faculty members of Social- Sciences and further bring out completed research into publishable material of high quality in the form of journal articles/books. The programme will give a thorough exposure to research methodology, data analysis with the help of SPSS, field research and academic writings. The programme includes interactive sessions, practical sessions and a discussion of field report, project proposals and sample research papers/outlines prepared by the participants during the training. The Programme is fully sponsored by **Indian Council for Social Science Research (ICSSR), MHRD-Govt. of India, New Delhi.**

Objectives of the programme:

The broad objective of the programme will be to develop research capabilities among faculty members in Social Sciences and specifically, the objectives will be to:

1. Develop capacity for conceptualizing and writing research proposals.
2. Enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research design, including conducting an overview of literature, formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of Information and analysis.
3. Enhance capacity for writing a research paper for publication.
4. Develop the capacity for planning and writing a book/monographs
5. Develop the capacity for grant applications/external funding

Eligibility and Application Procedure:

The Capacity Building Programme welcomes young faculty members in Social Sciences of Education, Teacher Education, Psychology, Commerce, Management, Economics, Sociology and Social Work, Anthropology, Political Science, Public Administration, Economics, History, Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology, Geography, Population Studies, Women Studies, Law & International Law and allied disciplines in research institutions, colleges and university postgraduate departments. Participants should have a minimum of a post graduate degree. Preference will be given to SC/ST, OBC, Minority, PWD and Women candidates.

There is **no registration** fee for the Capacity Building Programme. Intake of participants for the programme will be restricted to **30 (20 from outstation and 10 local)**. The selection of candidates will be done as per the ICSSR guidelines. The application will be scrutinized on the basis of academic qualifications, work experience, publications and the 200-words write up sent by the applicants. Decision of the Selection Committee in this regard is final. Subject to meeting the criteria, the selection will be on first come first served basis.

Only completely filled forms, duly signed and forwarded through proper channel will be accepted. The applicants selected for the programme will be informed through e-mail. Please be informed that application received after the deadline will be rejected and No correspondence whatsoever be made in this regard. The list of selected candidates will be displayed on www.nagalanduniversity.ac.in/English therefore the candidates are advised to be in touch with NU website.

The candidates may send an advanced scanned copy of the duly filled, signed and forwarded application form and other documents may be submitted to the Director on e-mail nucbp2018@gmail.com on or before **07-04-2018(Saturday)** followed by hard copy has to be submitted on the first day of the programme(08-05-2018,Thursday) to the Course Director. GENESIS OF NAGALAND UNIVERSITY:

Nagaland University, the 13th Central University and the only Central University in Nagaland was established based on the Act of Parliament of India and received the assent of the President of India on 20th October 1989 as THE NAGALAND UNIVERSITY ACT 1989 (No. 35 of 1989) and came into force as notified in THE GAZETTE OF INDIA EXTRAORDINARY PART-II SECTION-1 in October 1989 published by the Ministry of Law and Justice (Legislative Department), New Delhi.

The University came into being on September 6, 1994 having jurisdiction over the entire state of Nagaland. Prior to this, Nagaland had been in the catchment area of North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), with Kohima designated as one of the campuses of NEHU along with SASRD-Medziphema. With the establishment of Nagaland University, the two erstwhile campuses inherited from NEHU as well as the colleges affiliated to it fell within the jurisdiction of Nagaland University. The nascent University had to go through many teething problems initially. The Headquarters of the University, i.e. Lumami, as per the Act could not immediately accommodate the needful so as to start functioning as Headquarters. Hence, for nearly a decade and half Nagaland University had been functioning from Kohima as the interim Headquarters of the University. Meanwhile, the establishment of the academic departments was sanctioned by the Government in the year 1997. All the new departments had to be located at Lumami and started functioning with Kohima still as the interim Headquarters. Constructional activities started earnestly making it fit for academic pursuits at the Headquarters in the best possible way. Upon the completion of new constructions to a reasonable stage, the shifting of interim arrangement at Kohima to Lumami took place in the mid year of 2010.

At present the University has three campuses, viz. (i) Headquarters at Lumami in Zunheboto district (ii) Kohima Campus at Meriema in Kohima district (iii) Medziphema Campus (School of Agricultural Sciences and Rural Development) at Medziphema in Dimapur district and a temporary campus at Dimapur with one School (School of Engineering & Technology). There are 37 departments offering Undergraduate and Postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in different disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Engineering & Technology and Management streams. There are 65 colleges from all over the state of Nagaland currently affiliated to Nagaland University.

Kohima Campus:

The Kohima campus is spread over 240 acres and is located at Meriema, which is around 10 kms from the city center. The Kohima campus houses 11 departments namely Commerce, Education, English, Geology, Hindi, History & Archaeology, Linguistics, Psychology, Management, Teacher Education (M.Ed.), Tenyidie and 2 centres namely Centre for Naga Tribal Language Studies, Women Studies and caters to around 1000 Post-Grad and Doctorols students, and Research Scholars.

Department of Education

The Department of Education was established on 7th September, 1978 as Department of Educational Research, under NEHU, Nagaland Campus. Later it was re-named as Department of Education which came under Nagaland University on 6th September, 1994.

The Department offers Master of Arts degree course in Education. Duration of the MA programme consists of four semesters in 2 years covering sixteen course papers with a number of optional selective papers. In addition to the Masters Degree programme, Department offers Doctoral Research Study in Education. Presently there are several Ph.D and Post- Doctoral scholars working in the department. The Department of Education has at present four Professors, one Associate Professor and five Assistant Professors. Thrust areas of research are Teacher Education, Educational Testing, Educational Psychology, Measurement and Experimental design, Educational Technology, Special Education, Value Education etc.

Department of Teacher Education

Department of Teacher Education of the Nagaland University (A Central University) is situated in Kohima Campus Meriema. The Department of Teacher education covers all emerging areas of Education such as Educational Philosophy, Educational Psychology, Educational Administration, Research Methodology , Teacher Education, Information & Communication Technology, Inclusive Education, Distance Education, Value Education, Peace Education, Yoga Education, Environmental Education, Gender Issues etc. The main aim of Department of Teacher Education to prepare teacher educators who perform optimally in the colleges of Teacher Education/Schools and other related research areas. The Department of Teacher Education shall empower individuals to be torch bearers of social change by transforming society with a coordination of material and moral frame work of the groups to which individual belongs. The Department has four faculty members and offers Master of Education (M.Ed.) course.
