

How to reach Lumami

Anyone coming for the first time to Nagaland University Hqrs; Lumami from outside the state of Nagaland; the nearest Train station is Mariani, Assam. Jorhat is the nearest airport located in Assam. From both the stations it takes four hours to reach Mokokchung, Nagaland if board on taxi. If your journey route touches Gauwahati then there is a direct Blue Hills night bus to Mokokchung which will reach at 7:30 am-8:00am (tickets available @ Paltan Bazar and Bus Moves from ISBT-Bethkuchi, near Balaji Temple). After reaching Mokokchung volunteers will receive you in the station and further lead you to the venue.
