Introduction

The Department of Geology is located at the Kohima Campus of the Nagaland University, approximately 12 km north of Kohima Town. This was the first Science Department under the Nagaland University supported by the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, New Delhi for Level I of DST-FIST program in 2002. Based on the performance of the Department in teaching, research and students' placement, the DST further supported the Department by granting Rs.75 Lakh under DST-FIST Level I program in September 2013.

The Department offers a 2-year M.Sc. Geology course with an intake capacity of 15 students. The Department also runs Ph.D. program in various disciplines of Geology. The 2002 and 2014 NAAC Peer Teams recognised the Department as one of the most vibrant in the Nagaland University.

Nagaland is a picturesque state located on the eastern margin of NE India bordering Myanmar. Kohima, the capital town of Nagaland is connected to Dimapur (74 km) by the AH 1. The nearest Airport and Railway station are located in Dimapur. The temperature at Kohima varies from about 5°C in winter to about 30°C in summer. During November heavy warm clothing is required. An inner line permit (ILP) is necessary for entry into Nagaland. ILP's are issued at the Nagaland Houses at New Delhi, Kolkata, Guwahti and Shillong. The facility is also available in Dimapur at the office of the Deputy Commissioner. However, in order to help participants and invitees the Organising Committee shall arrange permission on availability of details in time.

Indian Society of Applied Geochemists

The Indian Society of Applied Geochemists (ISAG) was established in 1993 (Regd. No. 3614) at Hyderabad. Hyderabad is considered the capital city of Earth Sciences, being the home of several geoscientific institutions and organizations and is a hub for geological activities. ISAG aims at promoting the cause of advanced research in all branches of geochemistry for the benefit of society. The ISAG periodically organises national and international seminars, symposia and workshops on recent advancements. Intending participants are requested to send duly filled in Registration Forms and Abstracts pertaining to one or more of the above stated themes latest by 31st August 2016. Abstracts, not exceeding 500 words, should be submitted through Email in MS word format (A4 size, 1.5 spaced, Times New Roman, 12 point font size) with Email ID of corresponding author.

The size of each poster should be 1m x 1m and should be neatly prepared such that it can be easily read from a distance of one meter. Full papers must be typed as per guidelines of the JAG. Soft copies (in CD) of full papers must accompany the hard copies.

It is planned to bring out a Proceedings Volume comprising selected papers of the seminar.

Best Paper/Poster Award

Two awards for the best Research Paper and Poster shall be given at the valedictory Session of the seminar.
