

NAGALAND UNIVERSITY

“REGULATION ON INSTITUTIONAL GOVERNANCE AND ACADEMIC
ACCOUNTABILITY IN AFFILIATED COLLEGES, 2026”

WHEREAS Nagaland University is empowered under the Nagaland University Act, Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations to regulate affiliated colleges and recognised institutions.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to ensure compliance with statutory provisions, maintain academic standards, and provide a transparent mechanism for enforcement of penalties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the following Regulation is hereby promulgated:

1. Short Title, Extent and Commencement

1.1 This Regulation shall be called the Nagaland University (Regulation on Institutional Governance and Academic Accountability in Affiliated Colleges, 2026)

1.2 It shall extend to all colleges and recognised institutions affiliated with Nagaland University, whether under temporary or permanent affiliation.

1.3 It shall come into force with immediate effect from the date of its notification.

2. Objectives

This Regulation is intended to:

2.1 Ensure strict compliance with the provisions of the Nagaland University Act, Statutes, Ordinances, and Regulations.

2.2 Safeguard academic integrity, examination credibility, and institutional governance.

2.3 Align University-level enforcement with UGC/NCTE/AICTE and other regulatory standards, as well as NAAC quality assurance mechanisms.

2.4 Provide a transparent, graded, and legally enforceable penalty framework.

3. Violations of Conditions of Affiliation / Recognition

An affiliated college, recognised institution, or its management shall be liable for disciplinary action if it:

3.1 Minor Violations:

3.1.1 Admits students beyond the sanctioned intake capacity.

3.1.2 Submits statutory returns beyond the prescribed deadlines.

3.1.3 Collects unauthorised fees from students.

3.2 Major Violations:

3.2.1 Violates any condition of affiliation or recognition prescribed by the University.

3.2.2 Acts in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the University or detrimental to academic standards.

3.2.3 Introduces any course or programme, or establishes a campus, without prior approval of the University.

3.2.4 Fails to ensure a peaceful and malpractice-free examination environment.

3.2.5 Appoints faculty in violation of UGC or statutory council qualifications and prescribed selection norms.

3.2.6 Suppresses, fabricates, or manipulates academic or institutional data.

3.2.7 Fails to implement directions of the UGC/University relating to grievance redressal mechanisms.

3.2.8 Continues any programme after suspension or withdrawal of affiliation.

3.2.9 Commits any other act which, in the opinion of the University, constitutes a grave institutional or regulatory violation.

4. Categories of Penalties

4.1 Minor Penalties

4.1.1 Issuance of a written warning or reprimand.

4.1.2 Direction for immediate rectification within a stipulated timeframe.

4.1.3 Imposition of a monetary fine not less than ₹10,000 and extendable up to ₹1,00,000.



4.2 Major Penalties

- 4.2.1 Prohibition on the continuation of unauthorised courses or programmes.
- 4.2.2 Discontinuation of the institution as a centre for University examinations for a specified period.
- 4.2.3 Freezing of student admissions for one or more academic years.
- 4.2.4 Withdrawal of permanent affiliation for a period of three years, after which the college shall be required to reapply for such affiliation.
- 4.2.5 Temporary affiliated colleges/institutions shall not be eligible to apply for permanent affiliation for a period of five years.
- 4.2.6 Imposition of a monetary fine not less than ₹1,00,000 and extendable up to ₹10,00,000.
- 4.2.7 Any other punitive action deemed appropriate by the competent authority/Academic Council.

5. Procedure for Imposition of Penalty

- 5.1 Upon receipt of a complaint or upon suo motu satisfaction of a prima facie violation, the University shall issue a Show Cause Notice to the Principal of the erring college/institution.
- 5.2 The Principal shall submit a written explanation within fifteen (15) days.
- 5.3 If the explanation is not submitted or is found to be unsatisfactory, the University shall constitute an Inquiry Committee.
- 5.4 The Committee shall provide an opportunity of hearing, examine documentary and oral evidence, and submit its report within thirty (30) days.
- 5.5 The Competent Authority / Academic Council, as applicable, shall determine the quantum of penalty.

6. Non-Compliance with Penalty Orders

- 6.1 In the event of non-compliance, a fine of ₹1,000 per day shall be imposed for the first instance of default.
- 6.2 A fine of ₹2000 per day shall be imposed for the second and subsequent instances of default, until full compliance is achieved.

7. Emergency Powers

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Regulation, the Vice Chancellor/Academic Council may impose interim emergency measures, subject to post facto ratification by the appropriate authority.

8. Appeal Mechanism

8.1 Any aggrieved institution may prefer an appeal before the Competent Authority of the University within thirty (30) days from the date of the penalty order.

8.2 Based on the merits of the case, the Competent Authority may either dispose of the appeal or refer the matter to the Academic Council / Executive Council.

8.3 The decision of the Academic Council / Executive Council shall be final and binding.

9. Effect of Imposition of Penalty

The imposition of any penalty under this Regulation shall not be construed as regularisation, validation, or waiver of the irregularity committed by the institution.


10. Protection of Student Interest

10.1 The academic interests of students already admitted shall be duly protected.

10.2 Appropriate measures, including migration, transfer, or special examination arrangements, shall be made wherever feasible.

11. Power to Remove Difficulties

Any difficulty arising in the implementation of this Regulation shall be resolved by the Competent Authority in a manner consistent with the objectives of this Regulation/Statute.
