Guidelines for Ph. D. Admission (Winter Session) 2025 - 2026


1. List of Shortlisted candidates will be notified on the University website on **2nd Dec. 2025**.
2. Ph. D. entrance examination will be conducted in the department on **5th Dec. 2025 from 10.30 A.M** onwards.
3. The pattern for the entrance examination will be
 - Objective type (Paper No I) (MCQ) for **40 marks**. Descriptive (Paper No II) for **30 marks**.
Time: 10.30 A.M to 12.00 Noon
 - Syllabus will be based on M.A., Political Science old course syllabus, NU.
 - Descriptive question will be based on research methodology and area of research that the candidate intends to pursue for Ph. D.
 - Interview/Viva-Voce (**30 Marks**)
4. Only those candidates who secure the qualifying marks in Paper I & II (50%) will be called for Interview/Viva-Voce.
 - Results will be declared on **12th Dec. 2025**
 - Selection of the candidate will be purely based on merit.
5. All candidates must produce their original certificate (PG Marksheets, NET/JRF, ST/SC/OBC/EWS/PWD etc) for verification on the day of the examination.
6. The dates for admission to Ph. D. programme will be from **22nd Jan. 2026 to 30th Jan.2026**
7. Classes for Pre-Ph. D. course work will start from **5th Feb. 2026**
