ABOUT NAGALAND UNIVERSITY



The Nagaland University Act was passed by the Parliament Vide No. 35 of 1989 and established in 1994 as a Central University. The University has Kohima Campus at Meriema, & Agricultural (SAS) Campus at Medziphema. The Headquarter has been functional since 2010 at Lumami, Zunheboto. Currently, there are 6 (Six) Schools and 43 (Forty-three) Departments and 5 (Five) Centres.

Nagaland University is a Central University established on 6th September 1994 by an Act of Parliament (No.35 of 1989) with its headquarters at Lumami in Zunheboto District. It has two permanent campuses at Medziphema and Meriema (Kohima). The University has presently six Schools of Studies, viz. School of Sciences, School of Social Sciences, School of Agricultural Sciences, School of Humanities & Education, School of Engineering & Technology, and School of Management Studies. It has 43 Departments and 5 Centre's of Studies offering Undergraduate, Postgraduate, M.Phil., Ph.D. and Diploma/Certificate courses in various disciplines of Arts, Science, Commerce, Humanities, Agriculture Sciences, Engineering & Technology, Management and Law.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

For undergraduate programmes, applicants must:

- ❖ Have secured **55% or more** marks in their higher secondary education (10+2), or
- ❖ Be appearing for their higher secondary examination (10+2) from a recognized board such as CBSE, BSEB, AHSEC, ICSE, or any other recognized State/National Board



Admissions will be granted strictly on a merit basis, determined either by performance in the 10+2 examination or CUET-UG scores, as per the criteria of the respective department.
