IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. **How to apply:** Interested and eligible candidates must email their application to the Project Director at pumpau@nagalanduniversity.ac.in only. The application should include: a signed cover letter stating interest in the post applied for; an updated Curriculum Vitae (CV); self-attested scanned copies of all relevant certificates, mark sheets, experience certificates, and documents supporting educational qualifications and experience etc. All documents must be merged into a single PDF file. Incomplete applications or those missing

required documents will be summarily rejected. The email subject line must read: "Application for the Post of Research Assistant/Field Investigator for the ICSSR Project.

2. The last date for submission of the application is 10 July 2026 up to 11:59 PM.

3. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified by email regarding the online/offline interview (date & time). At least seven days' notice will be given before the interview date. No TA/DA or other allowances are admissible.

4. All fieldwork expenses of the project director and project personnel will be as per the rules of the affiliating university/institute.

5. All posts are temporary and coterminous with the project. Appointments will automatically terminate on completion of the ICSSR-funded research project.

6. Meeting the minimum eligibility criteria does not guarantee a call for interview or selection. The Screening/Selection Committee (File No. NUL/RDC/PF-204/2026 Dated 12.05.2026) reserves the right to shortlist candidates based on academic merit, research experience, and relevance to the project. Final selection will be made on the recommendation of the duly constituted Selection Committee and the decision of the university shall be final and binding.

7. Field Investigators will be engaged for short-term, phase-wise fieldwork of two months duration to conduct field studies and data collection across the three project states: Nagaland, Manipur and Mizoram. Given the nature of fieldwork, preference will be given to candidates familiar with the local context and fluent in the regional/local dialect to ensure effective communication with research participants.

8. The Research Assistant, supervised by the Project Director, will carry out literature reviews, develop questionnaires, and collect field data. Candidates should have skills in academic writing, research design, fieldwork, and data analysis software, with the ability to prepare timely reports for the funding agency in the prescribed format.
