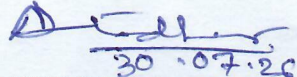

Guidelines for Admission to One-Year Postgraduate Programmes under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020

1. Short Title and Commencement

- 1.1. These Guidelines shall be called the Guidelines for Admission to One-Year Postgraduate Programmes under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
- 1.2. They shall come into force from the Academic Session 2026–2027 (or as approved by the Academic Council).
- 1.3. These Guidelines shall apply to:
 - All Postgraduate Departments of Nagaland University.
 - All Affiliated Colleges offering Postgraduate Programmes approved by Nagaland University.

2. Admission through Lateral Entry

A candidate seeking admission to the One-Year PG Programme shall satisfy the following conditions:

- 2.1. Must possess a Four-Year Bachelor's Degree with Honours or Honours with Research from:
 - Nagaland University or
 - Any recognised University.
- 2.2. The undergraduate degree must be in the same discipline or an allied/relevant discipline as determined by the concerned Department/College.
- 2.3. The candidate must satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 2.4. Where required, the Nagaland University Department may assess curricular equivalence before granting admission.

3. Determination of Curricular Equivalence

Where the Bachelor's Degree has been obtained from another University, the issue shall be referred to Nagaland University Department Admission Committee which shall examine:

- Core courses studied
- Credits earned
- Learning outcomes
- Laboratory/Practical components (where applicable)
- Discipline-specific requirements.

4. Intake Capacity

- 4.1. Admission through lateral entry shall be **10% supernumerary seats**, over and above the sanctioned intake capacity of the Two-Year PG Programme.

4.2. Where the sanctioned intake capacity of a Postgraduate Programme is not fully filled, the vacant seats within the sanctioned intake may be filled through lateral entry to the Third Semester by eligible candidates, subject to the provisions of these Guidelines.

5. Reservation Policy

Reservation of seats shall be governed as per extant rules.

6. Merit Preparation

Merit shall ordinarily be prepared on the basis of:

- Marks/CGPA obtained in the qualifying degree and/or
- Written Test
- Other criteria approved by the University

7. Documents Required

Candidates shall submit:

- Degree Certificate/Provisional Certificate
- Semester-wise Marksheets/Transcript
- Migration Certificate (where applicable)
- Category Certificate (if applicable)
- Aadhaar/Identity Proof
- Any other document prescribed by the University.

8. Award of Degree

Candidates admitted through lateral entry shall be awarded One-Year Master's Degree in the relevant discipline upon successful completion of all academic requirements prescribed by Nagaland University.

9. Power to Relax

The Nagaland University may relax any provision of these Guidelines in exceptional cases, provided such relaxation is consistent with:

- UGC Regulations
- NEP 2020
- Ordinances and Regulations of Nagaland University.

Notes

1. These Guidelines shall apply uniformly to Nagaland University Departments and Affiliated Colleges offering approved Postgraduate Programmes.
2. Affiliated Colleges shall admit students only to programmes specifically approved by Nagaland University.
3. Matters not covered under these Guidelines shall be governed by the relevant UGC Regulations, NEP 2020, Nagaland University Ordinances, and decisions of the Academic Council.
