About the University:

Nagaland University, the 13th Central University and the only Central University in Nagaland was established by an Act of Parliament (No. 35 of 1989) and received the assent of the President of India on 20th October 1989 as THE NAGALAND UNIVERSITY ACT 1989. The University came into being on 6th September, 1994 having jurisdiction over the entire state of Nagaland. At present the University has three campuses, viz. (i) Headquarters at Lumami in Zunheboto district (ii) Kohima Campus at Meriema in Kohima district (iii) and Medziphema Campus (School of Agricultural Sciences) at Medziphema in Chümoukedima district. There are 44 departments offering undergraduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in different disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Social Sciences, Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Engineering & Technology and Management streams. At present there are 77 colleges in Nagaland affiliated to Nagaland University.

About the ICSSR:

The Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) was established in 1969 by the Government of India to promote social science research nationwide. Its key objectives include monitoring and guiding social science research progress, providing financial support for research projects and programs, managing scholarships and fellowships, identifying and developing research areas, offering financial assistance to institutions and journals involved in social science research, fostering interdisciplinary collaborations, and advising the Government of India on social science research matters. Through ICSSR, the Indian government funds various aspects of social science research, such as projects, fellowships, international collaborations, capacity building, surveys, and publication support. Additionally, scholars can access library and information services through the National Social Science Documentation hub (NASSDOC) established by ICSSR. Furthermore, ICSSR operates the ICSSR Data Service, which serves as a national data service and enhances the research environment for social scientists in India. The ICSSR operates six regional centres, each located in specific regions across India, with roles including representing ICSSR locally, facilitating communication between regional social scientists and ICSSR, and connecting regional researchers with the wider national and international social science community

About the Department of Education:

The Department of Education was established on 7th September, 1978 as Department of Educational Research, under NEHU, Nagaland Campus. Later it was re-named as Department of Education which came under Nagaland University on 6th September, 1994. The Department is under the School of Humanities and Education. The Department of

education covers all emerging areas of Education such as Educational research and findings, Teacher Education, Educational Testing, Measurement and Experimental design, Educational Technology, Special Education, and Value Education. The Department offers two programmes i.e. P.G in Education & Ph.D. in Education and presently there are 50 Research Scholars pursuing their Ph.D. in Education.

Objectives of the Capacity Building Programme (CBP):

This Capacity Building Programme (CBP) is designed to empower Young Faculty Members in Social Sciences with the latest knowledge and skills in Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Academic Writing and Digital Learning Technology Integration in higher education. The Program focuses on transforming teaching learning processes using digital pedagogy in alignment with the NEP 2020, focusing on its key objectives, changes, and practical implementation strategies and also to impart the participants with knowledge of research methods, research process, use of research tools and techniques, writing and presentation skills to the young researchers for their overall development in their respective field. This programme is intended to provide the participants with a broad overview of methods and concepts (both quantitative and qualitative research) and as well as the tools and techniques used in the social sciences research along with Academic Writing Skills. The main objective behind this CBP is to give exposure on Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Academic Writing and Digital Learning Technology Integration in higher education. To provide researchers and educators with new tools and methods, artificial intelligence (AI) is having a big impact on both teaching and research. The programme aims at acquainting the participants with Academic Writing Skills including the methodologies of qualitative research, data analysis in qualitative research and encouraging them to undertake research in using mixed-methods and triangulation. Writing a research proposal, undertaking review of literature and then deciding upon the approach to research shall be dealt in detail during the programme.

Pedagogy:

Different topics of Academic Writing Skills and Digital Learning Technology Integration shall be taught through different pedagogical tools like lectures, hands-on training on computer software, assignments to write research Article, and designing instrument for data collection and field work for data collection. The participants will be required to make presentations and submit a report at the end of the workshop along with pre-test and post-test assessment.

Course Content:

The Capacity Building Programme (CBP) intends to build up knowledge of young researchers in the areas such as : Introduction of Academic and Research Writing, Literature review and sources of Information, Systematic literature review, Sources of Research Problem & Tips in Writing Objectives & Hypothesis, Hypotheses: Concept, Types, Formulation & Testing, Sampling Procedure & Sampling Methods, Data Collection Tools (Schedule, Interview, Observation, Rating Scales: Osgood, Bogardus, Thurston-Likert, Rating Scales: Guttman and other Tools), Development and Validation of Research Tools, Research Metrics and Reference Management Tools, AI tools in Research & Hands on Training, Articles Types and Structure, Selection & Submitting to the Right Journal, Place, Sources and issues of Research Publications, Research Paper Writing: Abstract Writing & Hands on Training, Research Paper Writing: Introduction, Methodology Writing & Hands on Training, Research Paper Writing: Results and Discussion Writing & Hands on Training, Research Paper Writing: Conclusion Writing & Hands on Training, Academic Integrity and Plagiarism detecting Software's & Hands on Training, Citation Indexing and Impact Factor, Report Writing, Different funding agencies and tips for proposal submission & Budgeting, The SWAYAM frameworks to implement NEP 2020 initiatives, Understand the impact of AI on Education, Explore the tools and techniques of digital pedagogy, Regulatory Frameworks and quality standards for MOOCs , NEP2020 and Education 4.0:Policy,Implementation,and Global Perspectives , AI and ICT Competencies for Personalised and Learner-Centric Pedagogies, Creating Experiential Learning through AI and Digital Platforms , Prompt Engineering and Generative AI Tools for Education, Designing Engaging e-Content Using AI Tools, AI in Research and Assessment: Tools and Techniques, Leveraging AI to enhance Open Educational Resources(OER) , Integration of Generative AI with Learning Management System[LMS] , E-Library Trying with Reference to OER & CC , Statistical Applications through SPSS (Descriptive and Inferential Statistics) and Hands on Training, The Indian knowledge systems, The application of decolonial frameworks as components of methodological and epistemological justice in social science research

Eligibility Criteria:

Interested candidates who are working as a Lecturer/Assistant Professor/Young Faculty in the field of Social Sciences (Education, Commerce, English, History & Archaeology, Linguistics, Psychology, Management, Teacher Education, Tenyidie, Centre for Naga Tribal Language Studies, Women Studies, Sociology, Social Work, Cultural

Studies, Gender Studies, Health Studies, Political Science, International Studies, Public Administration, Diaspora Studies, National Security and Strategic Studies, Social Psychology, Legal Studies, Social Geography, Environmental Studies, Modern Social History, Media Studies etc.) in UGC-recognized Indian Universities /Deemed Universities /Colleges/Institutes of National Importance and ICSSR Research Institutes or researchers in social science research are eligible to apply for the course. The selection for the course will be made in accordance with ICSSR guidelines. No leave of any kind is permissible during the course period. The CBP program is equivalent to Refresher Course in CAS promotion.

There is no registration fee for the selected participants, & Sessions will be conducted in English only.

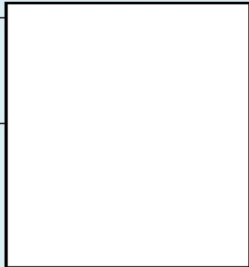
