2. Abstracts should be anonymous PDF and not include any identifying information (name of the author/s, affiliation and address).
3. **Length:** 1 page excluding tables and references.
4. **Format:** Times New Roman, font size 12, single space.
5. One person may submit a maximum of two abstracts with one as sole author and one as joint author.
